

LAKE POWELL RESORTS & MARINAS

FACT SHEET

LOCATION Lake Powell starts in northern Arizona and extends into southern Utah. It is part of the Colorado River in Glen Canyon National Recreation Area. In terms of mileage, Bullfrog Marina in Utah is 298 miles from Salt Lake City and 480 miles from Denver, Colorado. Wahweap Marina in Arizona is 267 miles from Las Vegas, 280 miles from Phoenix, 388 from Albuquerque, and 540 from Los Angeles, and an easy 2 hour drive from the Grand Canyon.

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OVERVIEW Lake Powell is America's favorite houseboating destination, according to *Houseboat Magazine*. Similar to the scenic beauty of the awe-inspiring Grand Canyon, Lake Powell is more than 400 feet deep, 186 miles long and offers nearly 2,000 miles of shoreline spectacular shoreline with towering red rock sandstone cliffs, more than 90 major canyons, brilliant blue-green water and beautiful sandy beaches.

Lake Powell is the second largest man-made lake in the U.S., and is located on the border of Utah and Arizona in Glen Canyon National Recreation Area. Lake Powell is situated in the heart of the “Grand Circle,” a collection of national parks and monuments, including the Grand Canyon, Zion, Bryce Canyon, Arches, Canyonlands, and Mesa Verde National Parks, Monument Valley, Canyon de Chelly, Navajo and the Grand Staircase-Escalante National Monuments.

Lake Powell enjoys an average springtime temperature in the 70s to 80s, while the summer heats up to the 90s to 100s. Warm water temperatures reach the high 70s by August.

THE EXPERIENCE

Lake Powell is the perfect place to create a comfortable and memorable family adventure with lodging and outdoor recreational activities for everyone – young and old alike. Visitors can soak up the bright sun, embark on a scenic cruise, enjoy a run on water skis, go river rafting or navigate by watercraft through countless coves. Other activities also available in the area but outside the park are jeep tours of canyons, including Antelope Canyon, and Hummer tours of Secret Canyons, bike rentals, and horseback riding. Or they can simply unwind next to a crackling campfire with family and friends and share legendary ghost stories.

From outdoor enthusiasts lured by the lake’s world-class fishing to Hollywood celebrities looking for an exotic film location or a tranquil place to relax, Lake Powell provides stunning scenery that is appreciated by millions of visitors annually.

HOUSEBOATS

Lake Powell Resorts & Marinas’ houseboats offer all the thrills of a vacation combined with all the comforts of home. Visitors can cruise through winding waterways to private alcoves, glide down their water slide into the lake, dock on beautiful sandy beaches and fire up the grill for a tasty outdoor feast as they embark on the adventure of a lifetime. Ranging from 48 to 75 feet, the houseboats offer many upgrades, including individual staterooms, watercraft storage ramps, as well as central heating and air conditioning. Houseboats are available in three classes:

Luxury Class: Top-of-the-line houseboats offering elegance and style, plus luxury amenities such as hot tubs, upgraded kitchen equipment, and satellite TV.

75' Odyssey

The most luxurious class of houseboat available, the Odyssey offers first-rate amenities that rival a four-star hotel. The houseboat sleeps up to 22 (12 maximum capacity while underway) and features six individual staterooms, three (3) three-quarters bathrooms, an eight-person hot tub, wet bar, two gas BBQs, fireplace, GPS tracking system and 24 bottle wine cooler— just to name a few of the amenities. Available at Wahweap Marina only.

75' Excursion

A commanding presence on the water, the Excursion sleeps up to 20 (12 maximum capacity while underway) people. This state-of-the-art vessel provides guests with the amenities and technology to have the ultimate houseboat experience. Featuring five staterooms, two bathrooms, hot tub, two gas BBQs, fireplace, GPS tracking system and many more luxury amenities.

62' Journey

The newest luxury addition to the fleet. Sleeping up to 16 people (12 maximum capacity while underway), this luxury class houseboat is equipped with 3 staterooms, 1 lower berth, upper deck driving helm, 8 person hot tub, two bathrooms, gas BBQ, TV with satellite tracking and many more amenities. Available at Wahweap marina only.

54' Escape

Introduced in 2008, the luxury-class Escape houseboat is available only at Bullfrog Marina. The Escape is ideal for vacationers looking for the luxury of the 75-foot Excursion, but on a smaller, more affordable scale. Sleeping up to 16 people (12 maximum capacity while underway), amenities include two staterooms, two lower berths, furnished kitchen and salon, one-and-a-half baths, an upper deck helm and an upper deck hot tub for up to eight people.

Deluxe Class: Upgraded houseboats with increased level of amenities, for extra comfort and enjoyment.

59' Discovery XL Platinum - NEW in 2010

The Discovery XL, one of the most popular houseboats at Lake Powell for the past 10 years, has been completely refurbished and created into a brand new model. The new Discovery XL Platinum houseboats which sleep up to 16 people (12 maximum capacity while underway) feature top-quality facilities without compromising the roomy living space and affordable price. Featured are two staterooms, two lower berths, two bathrooms and an upper deck driving helm. New heating, ventilation and

air conditioners have been installed, along with a new spiral staircase from the lower to upper decks.

59' Discovery XL

The Discovery-class luxury houseboats are popular vessels, sleeping up to 16 (12 maximum capacity while underway) and featuring two staterooms, two lower berths, one-and-a-half bathrooms, fully equipped kitchen, central heating and air conditioning, comfortable interior, wet bar, TV, VCR and CD sound system.

48' Navigator

The Navigator-class houseboats offer most of the first-rate amenities of the larger class vessels, but in a smaller, more nimble craft. The Navigator sleeps up to 14 people (12 maximum capacity while underway) and features a fully equipped kitchen, gas BBQ, water slide, two stereo systems, TV, VCR and DVD player.

Economy Class: Comfortable houseboats with amenities and equipment to ensure a pleasant houseboat experience.

53' Adventurer

The Adventurer-class houseboats offer many upgrades from the Voyager Class and provide an extra measure of comfort. The Adventurer houseboats sleep up to 12 people and include upgrades such as an RV style air conditioning, CD player and kitchen appliances.

46' Voyager and 46' Voyager XL

The Voyager XL class houseboats are available for rental at Wahweap boat rentals and feature all the basics of the Explorer-class with upgrades including, TV, VCR, DVD player and gas grill. The Voyager XL sleeps up to 12 people, and the Voyager sleeps 8 people.

46' Expedition and 46' Expedition II

The Expedition Class houseboat offers terrific amenities. The Expedition houseboat, available at Bullfrog Marina, sleeps up to six people and includes a private stateroom, CD stereo, TV with DVD player and air conditioning in a small and easy to handle plan. The Expedition II, available at Wahweap Marina, offers upgraded air conditioning, dual engines and upper deck sleeping mats, and sleeps up to 10 people.

LODGING

For those who prefer to stay on land, Lake Powell Resorts & Marinas offers high quality accommodations with sweeping views of the lake and a range of amenities. Accommodations include:

Lake Powell Resort

Lake Powell Resort is located at the south end of the lake and is steps away from Wahweap Marina and a short car ride from Page, Arizona. The resort, a three-diamond rated property, has 350 rooms, including double queens, kings and deluxe suites.

Lake Powell Resorts & Marinas completed the redesign of its lobby and retail store in spring of 2009. The lobby renovation entails an upgrade of the reception area providing guests with a single location for all their Lake Powell vacation planning needs. The retail store has been expanded by a 1000 square feet featuring a larger Native American handicraft section emphasizing cultural interpretation. Interactive elements like sample music tracks enhance the customers retail experience. The redesign project was

extended to Driftwood Lounge in 2010 and guests can now enjoy chic and casual dining with spectacular views

All rooms at the resort include in-room coffee. The resort amenities also include two crystal blue swimming pools, a hot tub, an exercise room including sauna, a dining room offering a wide array of choices to satisfy any palate, a lounge with friendly staff, Wi-Fi Internet access in the main lobby, Wahweap Grille, a seasonal casual family restaurant with pizza and hamburgers, and gift stores with something for everyone.

Defiance House Lodge

Defiance House Lodge is located towards the north end of the lake at Bullfrog Marina in Utah. The lodge is nestled on a red rock mesa overlooking miles of picturesque shoreline and includes 48 rooms, all recently renovated. Visitors can pick up souvenirs in the gift shop or simply relax in the dining room or out on the patio.

All rooms have been updated with new furniture, a mini-fridge, a microwave and a 27-inch television as well as new fixtures and wall decorations. Wi-Fi Internet access is available throughout the lodge, including the lobby and restaurant area.

Family Units

Halls Crossing, Bullfrog and Hite Marinas offer three-bedroom family units that include all the comforts of home, complete with two baths, living rooms and fully equipped kitchens. The family units sleep up to eight people and provide a down-home atmosphere that is hard to beat.

CAMPGROUNDS & RV PARKS

Lake Powell Resorts & Marinas operates campground and RV park facilities at Wahweap, Bullfrog and Halls Crossing.

The campground sites include tables and grills, with water and flushing toilets nearby. Reservations are on a first-come, first-serve basis and must be made upon arrival. Additionally, primitive camping is available at Hite.

The RV sites include full hook-ups and picnic tables. Shower /restroom facilities are available at both locations. RV sites can be reserved along with group sites. However, campgrounds with non-hook-up sites are first come, first serve.

Pets are welcome at Wahweap, Bullfrog and Halls Crossing RV and campground facilities at no additional charge. Pets should not be left unattended and must be on a leash.

Memorial Day through Labor Day weekend, the National Park Service rangers at Wahweap Marina present interpretive programs Friday and Saturday evenings. Programs are given at the Wahweap outdoor

amphitheater. Please ask for program schedule when registering at the Wahweap campground store.

Specific amenities for each campground/RV Park include:

Wahweap RV Park and Campground

Wahweap Campground/RV Park features a total of 139 full hook ups, 112 non-hook ups and six group tent sites for camping. Reservations are required for the group sites. Amenities include coin-operated laundry and shower facilities, a convenience/gift store, picnic tables, grills and a RV dump station.

Guests can ride a free shuttle service to all areas in Wahweap and enjoy the two swimming pools located at Lake Powell Resort. The facilities are open year round.

RV Park (Bullfrog)

The RV Park features 20 pull-through spaces and four back-in spaces. Visitors must check in at the Defiance House Lodge front desk. 24 new full hook up spaces coming soon!

Village Center (Halls Crossing)

Village Center RV Park is comprised of 32 pull-through spaces. Visitors must check in at the Village Store.

Hite RV Park and Campground

8 new full hook up sites coming soon!

DINING

Lake Powell Resorts & Marinas offers a delightful array of casual dining. Visitors can feast at the Rainbow Room Restaurant located in Lake Powell Resort, the Wahweap Grille (open seasonally), located near the main boat launch ramp at the Resort, and the Anasazi Restaurant in Defiance House Lodge at Bullfrog. Each of the dining facilities offers panoramic views of Lake Powell's red rock sandstone cliffs and miles of blue crystal water. Guests at the Lake Powell Resort can also enjoy a quick snack, coffee or smoothie at Java City, located in the resort lobby.

The Rainbow Room

In addition to panoramic views of the lake's sapphire-blue water and the red rock buttes just beyond Wahweap Marina, Lake Powell Resort's famed Rainbow Room offers guests a complete breakfast menu, hearty lunches and dinner entrees ranging from fresh fish to flame-broiled beef, followed by indulgent chef-inspired desserts.

As part of ARAMARK's sustainable cuisine initiatives, the Rainbow Room menu is comprised of more than 50 percent sustainable and organic dishes that use produce and foods grown and raised without pesticides or chemical fertilizers. Seasonal fruits, vegetables and dinner specials are also featured throughout the year.

MARINA SERVICES

Lake Powell Resorts & Marinas offer services to meet almost any need. Fuel stations are available at Wahweap, Bullfrog, Halls Crossing, Hite, and Dangling Rope. Towing and repair services are available at Wahweap, Bullfrog and Halls Crossing Marinas. Wahweap Marina also provides pilot services, private fishing guides, general maintenance, multi ownership management and housekeeping services. Each of the marinas has a snack bar, a store that offers essential provisions such as food, ice, film and toiletries, as well as fishing licenses, maps, public phones and restrooms.

POWERBOATS

No houseboat experience is complete without a powerboat or fishing boat adventure. Visitors can skim across Lake Powell's winding waterways and hidden coves, and discover secluded canyons and great fishing spots. The power and fishing boats at Lake Powell Resorts & Marinas are spacious and easy to drive. The experienced rental staff can offer insight and assistance in selecting and operating the crafts. Boats range in size from 19 to 23 feet and include:

- **19' All Purpose Boat** (Available at Bullfrog & Wahweap Marinas): Seats 7, 150 hp outboard, good for cruising the lake, fishing, family fun, such as tubing, and entry level skiing. Daily rate: \$400.00 plus tax.
- **20' Baja Ski Boat** (Available at Bullfrog & Wahweap Marinas): Seats 7, 260 hp I/O engine, with more power for intermediate to advanced skiing. Daily rate: \$584.00 plus tax.
- **23' Baja Boat** (Available at Wahweap Marina Only): Seats 7, 6.2 liter I/O engine, used for power sightseeing and advanced skiing. Daily rate: \$584.00 plus tax.
- **23" Centurion Wakeboarding Boat (Available at Wahweap Marina Only): Seats 7, 6.2 liter I/O engine, used for wakeboarding and advanced skiing. Daily rate: \$584.00 plus tax.**

Note: Not all boats are available at every marina.

PATIO BOATS

36' Weekender

Introduced in 2008, Lake Powell Resorts & Marinas now offers 36-foot "Weekender" patio boats, which provide a new, relaxing way to gather with friends and family on the lake. The Weekender is a 36- by 12-foot, open-sided pontoon boat and features a waterslide, a propane grill with side burner, restroom and rear-deck shower, refrigerator, ice chest, AM/FM CD player and three oversized upper deck cushions for sleeping under the stars.

WATER TOYS

Lake Powell Resorts & Marinas also offers countless water activities and toys that are sure to keep visitors hopping from sun up 'til sun down. Toys include:

Note: All Ski Tube, Water Ski, Kneeboard and Wakeboard packages must have a minimum of three people: a driver, a spotter and a skier.

AGUA TIERRA TRAIL

This paved and accessible nature trail leads through desert landscape. This is an easy trail that winds through just over a half mile, starting at Lake Powell Resort and ending at the Wahweap Ranger Station where dinosaur tracks are on display. A trail guide is available at the kiosk located at the trailhead.

WILDERNESS RIVER ADVENTURES

Grand Canyon Whitewater Rafting

An exhilarating way to see the Grand Canyon is through Wilderness River Adventures' motorized and oar powered trips, which range from three-and-a-half to 14 days.

The experienced crews guide passengers through challenging rapids while offering interesting stories of geology, history and early canyon explorers and inhabitants. Travelers will be treated to fully prepared, top-of-the-line meals, a wide array of refreshments and well-maintained camping sites. Guests often find that these Wilderness River Adventures' trips provide them with the experience of solitude and quiet, outside of their daily lives, that brings about reflection and meditation. As this is a more intense experience, passengers must be at least eight years old for the motorized trips, and 12 years of age is the recommended minimum for the rowing adventures.

Cataract Canyon Whitewater Rafting

The new white water rafting trips by Wilderness River Adventures take visitors into the heart of Cataract Canyon which lies deep within Canyonlands National Park located in Southeast Utah. The expeditions start at Potash, just south of Moab, and traverse a total of 96 miles through Cataract Canyon, all the way to Hite Marina on Lake Powell. Along the journey, visitors can enjoy breathtaking views of sculpted sandstone, hike to ancient Puebloan cliff dwellings to view primitive petroglyphs and granaries, and experience a unique blend of calm waters and exciting rapids all wrapped into one.

SCENICBOAT TOURS

Scenic cruises are available to Rainbow Bridge National Monument and Antelope Canyon, as well as a number of other picturesque locations. Cruises last from one hour to all day and offer breathtaking views of colorful bays, brilliant blue water and winding canyons.

Lake Powell Resorts and Marinas introduced audio headsets with interpretive narration on all scenic cruise adventure tours in 2009. Individual audio sets will be included with every tour, allowing guests to enjoy the narration at their own pace, learn about the history of the region, and appreciate the interpretive aspects of what Lake Powell has to offer. Audio will be available in English, German, French, Italian and Japanese, and will be interactive, lively and upbeat with music and sound effects. The interpretive narration will be available to guests taking tours this summer and also available for download as a podcast on www.lakepowell.com

Cruises include:

Rainbow Bridge Cruise

Sculpted by wind and water, spanning 275 feet and reaching a height of 290 feet, Rainbow Bridge is one of the most photographed geological wonders in the American West. In 2009, Rainbow Bridge commemorated 100 years since its rediscovery—a centennial inspiring locals and visitors alike through its wondrous size, majesty and mystery. 2010 marks the 100th anniversary of Rainbow Bridge becoming a National Monument.

The cruise is approximately six hours and allows visitors to enjoy the spectacular scenery as they are transported in comfort. The trip includes a trip to a side canyon and a rest stop at Dangling Rope Marina where ice cream and snacks are available.

The cruises depart daily, in season, from Lake Powell Resort.

Canyons Adventure Cruise

The Canyons Adventure Cruise is a scenic voyage to dramatic Navajo Canyon, with dark desert varnish that appears like a tapestry on towering

rock walls, and grand views of Tower Butte and Glen Canyon Dam. This cruise lasts two and a half hours and includes a trip to Antelope Canyon.

Antelope Canyon Cruise

The Antelope Canyon Cruise is a scenic trip to the water-accessible portion of the famed Antelope Canyon, with its dramatic steep, red sandstone walls. Trip lasts one and a half hours and includes a view of Glen Canyon Dam.

CANYON PRINCESS

The luxurious 96' Canyon Princess features richly appointed climate controlled cherry wood salons, a curved grand staircase and large open-air decks. With a full-service bar, dining on two levels and a large dance floor, the Canyon Princess can accommodate more than 100 guests for weddings, chartered events and other special celebrations.

Canyon Princess Sunset Dinner Cruise

The Sunset Dinner Cruise aboard the luxurious Canyon Princess offers visitors an opportunity to enjoy the best view of the breathtaking, towering red rocks at sunset while feasting on menu selections, offering beef, fish, or chicken entrées accompanied by seasonal vegetables and chef's choice of sides. Not offered during the winter season.

Note: Advance reservations are recommended and there is a 20-passenger minimum required for sight seeing and a 25-passenger minimum required for Canyon Princess food cruises. For the winter season tours operate on a seasonal schedule, please visit www.lakepowell.com for the most up-to-date tour schedule.
